RESOLUTION NO. 2025-

APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR THE PIPELINE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara Valley Water District (Valley Water) has been duly and regularly established and exists pursuant to the provisions of the Santa Clara Valley Water District Act (District Act); and

WHEREAS, the Pipeline Maintenance Program (PMP) is included in the Board of Directors' approved Draft Fiscal Years 2026-2030 Capital Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of April 2025, the Engineer's Report for the PMP prepared by Valley Water's Engineer, titled "Pipeline Maintenance Program" dated March 2025, was made available to the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of April 2025, this Board of Directors set a time and place for a Public Hearing on the Final Program Environmental Impact Report and Engineer's Report to take place on the 22nd day of April at 1:00 p.m., at Valley Water, in the Boardroom, at 5700 Almaden Expressway, San Jose, California, and by teleconference Zoom meeting; and

WHEREAS, notice of the time and place of said Public Hearing was duly given and published pursuant to law; and

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of April 2025, Valley Water's Engineer presented the Engineer's Report dated March 2025 to the Board of Directors, containing:

- 1. A general description of the PMP;
- 2. A general description of zone of benefits, project right of way, and maps showing the location of the PMP and Pipeline Systems Map; and
- 3. An estimate of cost of the PMP and means of financing the cost; and

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of April 2025, at the time and place as set by the Board of Directors, a Public Hearing was duly held.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Santa Clara Valley Water District:

SECTION 1

That all comments including all written and oral objections to the proposed PMP have been heard and considered; and

SECTION 2

That this Board hereby approves said Engineer's Report for a work of improvement for the Pipeline Maintenance Program; and

SECTION 3

That the Valley Water Engineer has estimated the current total cost of the Project is \$55 million. The Project is funded entirely by the Water Utility Fund (Fund 61) with 100% of the costs allocated to North County Zone W-2.
