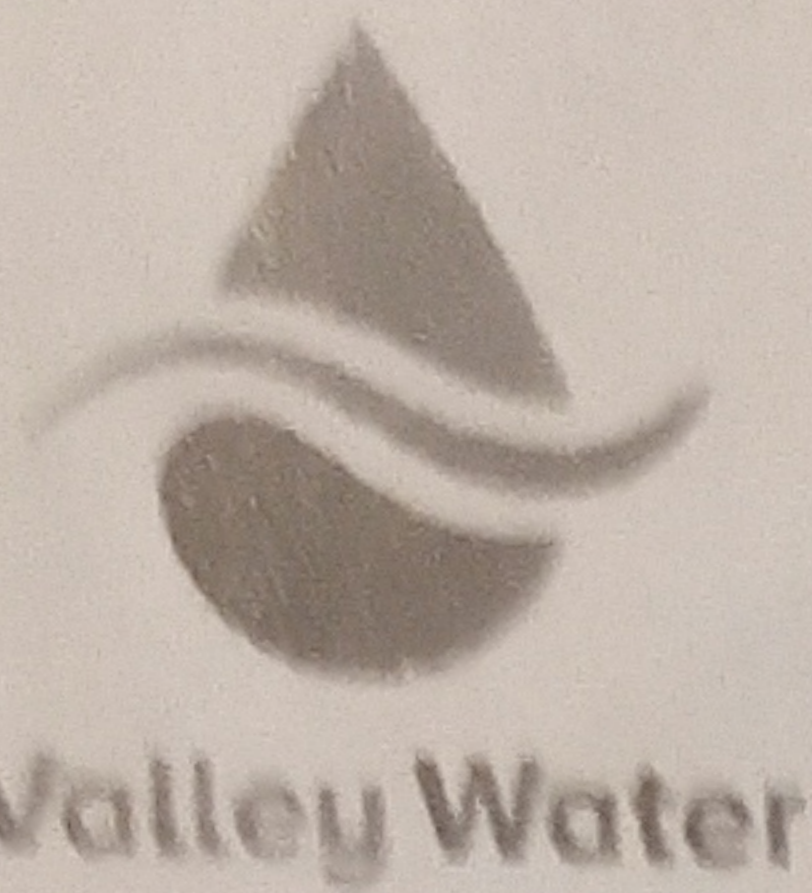

VALLEY WATER'S FIRST STOP WAS MY TENT (HOME) VALLEY WATER EMPLOYEES TORE UP MY TENT (LEAVING THE BATHROOM) 2. ENTERED ILLEGALLY, AND VANDALIZED MY HOME. VALLEY WATER EMPLOYEES DIDNT EVEN CLEAN UP THE MESS, AND DEBRIS THEY LEFT BEHIND. VALLEY WATER CONTINUED TO DRIVE TOWARDS THE OTHER 5 TENTS AND TOOK 3 BAGS (WHICH WERE ON TOP OF THE DIRT RD) AND ONLY THAT.
