	Chair Hsueh	Public Hearing Background	On February 27, 2024, the Board directed staff to update the CIP Draft FY 2025-29 Five-Year Plan prior to release for public review, to reflect the staff-recommended assumption presented in the 2024 Protection and Augmentation of Water Supplies Report.
			Following this direction, on March 13, 2024, the updated CIP Draft FY 2025-29 Five-Year Plan was released to all cities and land use authorities in Santa Clara County and the County of Santa Clara for review as to its consistency with their General Plans.

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			Pursuant to California Government Code §65403(d), before adopting a capital improvement program, the governing body of a special district is required to hold at least one public hearing.
			The public hearing is being held for Valley Water's Five- Year Plan so that representatives of the cities, townships, County or the public may appear and submit comments and information to the Board of Directors regarding the CIP Draft FY 2025-29 Five-Year Plan.
