At a recent meeting of local environmental organizations, attendees expressed concern about the modification of Safe, Clean Water and Natural Flood Protection Program Project F6 -- Good Neighbor Program: Graffiti and Litter Removal and Public Art KPI #3 to expand public art projects beyond Valley Water-owned infrastructure and property. Most of the concern is due to the possible impacts from lighting. Lighting to specifically illuminate artworks should not be allowed.

It is likely that other interested parties would have comments or questions about implementation of this expanded public arts funding. Therefore, I encourage the Board to request that the Board Planning and Monitoring Committee develop and approve specific public art grant requirements under the Safe Clean Water Program so the public and interested parties can provide input.

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
