This memorandum summarizes agenda items from the regular meeting of the RWC held on Wednesday, May 27, 2026.

Receive an update on the Desalination Engineering Feasibility Study.

The Committee received the information, took no formal action, and noted the following: The Committee expressed appreciation to staff for the comprehensive update and awaits more information on timelines and engineering studies, Director Beall expressed interest in touring existing or under construction desalination facilities, and staff stated that Director Beall and staff toured the Antioch Desalination Facility on November 13, 2025. Chairperson Estremera indicated that he and Vice Chairperson Santos have toured a Carlsbad Desalination Facility, Staff stated they estimate the permitting process takes about eight years.

Receive Pure Water Silicon Valley Update, Including Demonstration Facility and Full-Scale Direct Potable Reuse Facility at the Silicon Valley Advanced Water Purification Center; and Ongoing Outreach.

The Committee received the information without discussion and took no formal action.

Receive Update on the Site Works Agreement with the City of San Jose, Valley Water and Microsoft Corporation.

The Committee received the information, took no formal action, and noted that Vice Chairperson Santos plans to attend the data center groundbreaking ceremony in June 2026.

Review and Discuss the 2026 Recycled Water Committee (RWC) Work Plan and Make Adjustments as Necessary, and Confirm the Committees Next Meeting Date.

The Committee received the information, took no formal action, and agreed to cancel the June 24, 2026 meeting and consolidate items to the July 29, 2026 meeting.
