Subject: NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CONSIDER THE ADOPTION OF A RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY BY EMINENT DOMAIN

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure, Section 1245.235, that it is the intention of the Board of Directors of the Santa Clara Valley Water District to consider the adoption of a resolution declaring the public necessity for the acquisition of real property or interest therein required for purposes of the Coyote Creek Flood Protection Project.

The resolution, if adopted, will authorize staff and counsel to commence an eminent domain proceeding to acquire the property, which is described in the attached Exhibit A.

Notice is further given that the Board is scheduled to meet to consider adoption of the Resolution of Necessity at its **October 14, 2025** meeting which begins at **1:00 PM** at the District's Headquarters building, 5700 Almaden Expressway, San Jose, California. The meeting will also be live streamed on the district's website.

Notice of Your Right to Appear and Be Heard

Interested Persons or Parties are entitled to appear at the place and time set forth above and be heard on the following matters:

- 1. Whether public interest and necessity require the project;
- 2. Whether the project is planned or located in the manner that will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury;
- 3. Whether the property sought to be acquired is necessary for the project;

If you wish to appear and be heard, you must file a written request to appear and be heard with the Clerk of the Board of Directors at the Santa Clara Valley Water District, 5750 Almaden Expressway, San Jose, California, 95118 within 15 days after this notice was mailed.

Failure to file such written request within the time specified constitutes a waiver of the right to appear and be heard.

Please be advised that, notwithstanding the statutory language indicating that there is an "intent" to condemn, the Directors have not in fact made a determination whether to condemn and will not so determine except in accordance with evidence and disclosures which will be heard at the time and place noted above.

If the Board elects to adopt the Resolution of Necessity, then within six months of the adoption of the Resolution, Valley Water would commence eminent domain proceedings in the Santa Clara County Superior Court. In that proceeding, the Superior Court will determine the amount of compensation to which you would be entitled.
