SUBJECT:

Conduct a Continued Public Hearing on Proposed Modifications to Projects under Priorities E and F of the Safe, Clean Water and Natural Flood Protection Program. (Continued from July 14, 2026).

REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM:

This report conveys additional information received after the initial report was released, consistent with Executive Limitations Policy EL-7-10-5.

RECOMMENDATION:

Conduct a continued Public Hearing to receive comments on the proposed modifications to the following projects in the Safe, Clean Water and Natural Flood Protection Program: **Project E5:** San Francisquito Creek Flood Protection, and **Project F6:** Good Neighbor Program: Graffiti and Litter Removal and Public Art; and

- A. Close the public hearing, deliberate, and if appropriate, take action on the proposed modification(s); or
- B. Continue the public hearing to a subsequent regularly scheduled Board meeting as determined by the Board.

SUMMARY:

*Next Steps

At the August 11 public hearing, the continued public hearing following the opening of the public hearing on July 14, the Board will determine whether to close the public hearing, deliberate and consider adopting the attached resolution(s) modifying KPIs for Project E5 and/or Project F6; or continue the hearing to a future regularly scheduled Board meeting.

Regarding Project E5:

The Board may consider either:

- adopting the Resolution modifying the KPI, as originally recommended (Supplemental Attachment 1); **or**
- in response to public comments received during the public hearing, postponing action on the proposed modification and requesting that the SFCJPA Board consider forming a Working Group, comprised of two to three Board members from the SFCJPA and Valley Water boards, to jointly review and address these public comments. A draft letter from the Valley Water Board Chair to the SFCJPA Board of Directors is attached for the Board's consideration (Supplemental Attachment 2).

Regarding Project F6:

No changes are proposed to the recommendation contained in the original Board Agenda Memorandum. If the Board closes the public hearing, it may consider adopting the Resolution modifying the KPI for Project F6 (Supplemental Attachment 3).
