SUPPLEMENTAL BOARD AGENDA MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT:

Update on Santa Clara Valley Water District's Membership in the San Luis and Delta-Mendota Water Authority.

REASON FOR SUPPLEMENTAL MEMORANDUM:

This memorandum conveys additional information received after the initial memorandum was released, consistent with Executive Limitations Policy EL-7-10-5, which allows for additional information received after the initial report was released to be provided less than 10 days prior to the date of the board meeting.

RECOMMENDATION:

Receive information on the Santa Clara Valley Water District's (Valley Water) membership in the San Luis and Delta-Mendota Water Authority (SLDMWA) and the benefits that Valley Water receives from that membership.

SUMMARY:

This Supplemental Agenda Memo provides an updated PowerPoint presentation. The original PowerPoint was posted and developed to meet the Board's request to bring this item forward in a timely fashion.

Since posting the original PowerPoint, Valley Water staff consulted with San Luis Delta-Mendota Authority staff and updated the PowerPoint. Additional examples and details, aligning with the San Luis Delta-Mendota Water Authority (SLDMWA) Strategic Plan, are included in the updated PowerPoint.

This information item is in response to a future agenda item request from Directors Santos and Varela at the March 26, 2019, Board of Directors meeting.

Santa Clara County relies on water conveyed through the Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta by the State Water Project and Central Valley Project (CVP) to meet, on average, 40 percent of its annual water needs. The San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority (SLDMWA) was formed in 1990 to

assume the responsibility of operation and maintenance (O&M) of Delta Mendota Canal, pump stations and associated facilities.

This agenda item describes the activities SLDMWA has historically engaged in and discusses recent changes to the organization and its plan for future activities.
