

Project Planning Assessment Criteria


Prioritization Criteria and Weighting		
Criterion	Notes	Weighting
Economics	Including capital and O&M costs and rate/customer affordability impacts	25%
Countywide (regional) supply reliability	Including GW protection (quality and quantity) and dry year/drought resilience benefits	25%
Environmental impacts/benefits and sustainability	Including environmental impacts/benefits, energy use, and GHG production	20%
Ease of implementation and regulatory compliance	Including governance/partnership, public acceptance, permitting/compliance, environmental and social justice, timing (readiness to proceed), and staff resource considerations	15%
Engineering feasibility	Including water quality (source and product water), monitoring requirements, and treatment technology	15%
Total		100%
