



Los Vaqueros Reservoir Expansion Project Update

December 10, 2024

Recent Project Activity

- CCWD 9/18 Board Meeting – CCWD Board concluded the Project is no longer viable and directed staff to develop a plan to withdraw from the Project.
- October/November 2024 – LVE JPA, BBID, and Congressmen Josh Harder and Jim Costa, sent letters urging CCWD to reconsider decision to withdraw from the Project.
- CCWD 11/6 Board Action – Adopted Resolution to authorize staff to:
 - Withdraw Los Vaqueros Project’s Prop 1 WSIP funding application and
 - Coordinate with LVE JPA staff and other LVE JPA members to begin dissolution of the LVE JPA.
- LVE JPA 11/13 Board Meeting – Directed LVE JPA staff to develop and bring a plan for dissolution of the JPA to the LVE JPA Board meeting on January 8, 2025.

Next Steps

- Dissolution of the LVE JPA requires 75% approval vote from JPA members and ratification by 75% of JPA member agency home boards.
- LVE JPA 1/8 Board Meeting – Vote to adopt resolution for dissolution of the LVE JPA.
- Return to Valley Water Board in February to ratify LVE JPA's resolution.
- LVE JPA would finish any wind-down activities.
- Any remaining funds would be divided amongst the JPA member agencies.
 - \$11.2 million remaining as of Sept. 30th
 - Some of these funds will be spent on wind-down activities
