Volunteer Experience

2020-2025 Volunteer Journalist

Over the span of five years, I authored a biweekly column for the Bay Area News Group called Green Rides that appeared in the Drive Section of the San Jose Mercury News and the East Bay Times. The articles featured promotional reviews of clean vehicles and current events surrounding vehicle emission regulations. I provided the content for free, which appeared under my pen name, Peter Douglas. During this time-period, I also provided a few full-length articles to the Electric Vehicle Association and submitted extensive comments to the Environmental Protection Agency and the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in conjunction with their rulemaking processes.

2009-2018 Gardening Club Director

I spent the last years of my teaching career at Glider Elementary School, which had an enclosed gardening area that had gone untended for many years. I organized a small group of students and parents interested in renovating the garden, and over the years the Gardening Club grew dramatically, requiring two after-school meetings per week to accommodate all the participants. Glider's Rainbow Garden featured mostly ornamental plants and trees, and the program emphasized drought tolerant plants and the environmental benefits of organic fertilizers. I continued the popular program after I retired from teaching in 2014. The program ended when the school closed in 2018.

2014-2018 Children's Choir Director

I directed after-school choral programs at many of the elementary schools where I taught over the years, and I was Oak Grove School District's traveling vocal music teacher for two years. When I retired from teaching, I founded an after-school choral program at Glider Elementary School that initially served the youngest students and grew to include a more advanced group of older students. The choral program ended when the school closed in 2018.

1981-1982 Peace Corps Volunteer

I joined the Peace Corps after graduating from U.C. Santa Cruz and was assigned to teach mathematics in Ghana, West Africa. I mostly taught Algebra and Geometry to college students who were training to become teachers in Ghana's public school system.
