This memorandum summarizes discussion and action from the meeting of the Environmental Creek Cleanup Committee (ECCC) held on April 24, 2026.

RECEIVE A PRESENTATION FROM THE SANTA CLARA COUNTY OFFICE OF SUPPORTIVE HOUSING: REGARDING THE DRAFT “SANTA CLARA COUNTY: COMMUNITY PLAN TO END HOMELESSNESS.”

Discussion ensued relating to interagency coordination to find housing for individuals living along the creeks, the use of 2016 Measure A funds to house individual, whether funds in the original bond is fully committed, housing for farmworkers, and accommodations for disabled individuals.

The Committee received the information and took no formal action.

RECEIVE AN UPDATE ON VALLEY WATER’S MAINTENANCE ACTIVITIES ON THE COYOTE-ALAMITOS CANAL

Discussion ensued relating to whether the canal can be sold to an open space district or handed off to the Santa Clara County Parks Department, the Capital Improvement Program Committee’s monitoring of the canal, and Valley Water’s obligation to maintain unused properties owned by the organization.

The Committee received the information and took no formal action.

RECEIVE UPDATE ON VALLEY WATER’S ENCAMPMENT CLEANUP OPERATIONS

Discussion ensued relating to the renewal of the Agreement between Valley Water and the County of Santa Clara to provide outreach efforts and Valley Water’s contributions under the agreement.

The Committee received the information and took no formal action.

REVIEW THE ENVIRONMENTAL CREEK CLEANUP COMMITTEE (ECCC) WORK PLAN.

Director Beall requested that staff add any November ballot measures within the Committee’s purview to the next meeting agenda. Chairperson Santos noted that, per staff’s recommendation, the next Committee meeting will take place on a date to be determined in October 2026.
