STATE ADVOCACY EFFORTS

Legislative Days in Sacramento

On May 20 and 21, Director Ballard and Director Beall led senior staff in a series of 19 meetings with state legislators and Governor Newsom's Administration's officials. Several priority issues were discussed, including Valley Water's budget priorities, the Delta Conveyance Project, the Anderson Dam Seismic Retrofit Project, and numerous other state policy issues regarding water supply, flood protection, and environmental stewardship for the people of Santa Clara County.

These trips to Sacramento help Valley Water effectively advocate for our policy and funding priorities to state-level decision makers. The success of this 2025 trip will be revealed by state policy outcomes in the coming months, most notably the state budget and other legislation.

FEDERAL ADVOCACY EFFORTS

Directors and Staff Engage with Partner Agencies, Regulators at ACWA Spring Conference

Several directors and staff attended the Association of California Water Agencies (ACWA) Conference in Monterey on May 13-15 to meet with partner organizations and federal regulatory agencies, as well as to learn from subject matter experts on issues of concern to the California water community. Valley Water attendees met with these stakeholders to identify opportunities for collaboration and advocate for shared priorities, including advancing the Sisk Dam Raise Project. Staff also met with the Bureau of Reclamation to express appreciation for the agency's support and collaboration, and to advocate for federal priorities like CVP operations, conveyance capacity repair, and the Sisk Dam Raise Project. The Office of Government Relations coordinates and participates in these side meetings in order to advocate with these agencies to advance Valley Water projects and initiatives.
