

The DEI Master Plan effort is nearing completion. Interviews have been held with all Valley Water divisions, staff members, Employee Resource Groups (ERGs), Labor Relations and union representatives with final interviews being completed in June. The Masterplan project began last fall and is scheduled to conclude this summer. A draft report is anticipated to be completed by the end of July.

RESOLUTIONS

This past month the Board approved three new resolutions. The staff coordinated internal and Employee Resource Group (ERG) resolution efforts over this year, to ensure a consistent acknowledgement of observances throughout the year. The following three resolutions were adopted by the Board on May 24, 2022:

- Resolution proclaiming June 2022 as National Caribbean Heritage Month.
- Resolution proclaiming June 2022 as LGBTQ PRIDE Month.
- Resolution proclaiming June 19 as Juneteenth Independence Day.

Updates to Employee Resource Groups Policy

The Office of REDI is nearing completion of the development of an ERG policy that clarifies, in part, the roles of ERGs with that of the Office of Racial Equity, Diversity & Inclusion. This new policy more clearly explains how ERGs can advance their respective missions and how best to work with REDI to help recruit members, promote special events, manage spending allocations and conduct elections. The goal is to enable the alignment of ERG initiatives with agency-wide goals to advance DEI at Valley Water and the communities we serve.
