Project Participation Considerations

- Project is currently fully subscribed
 - 25 existing participants
 - Reclamation to increase participation from 7% up to potentially 25%
 - Valley Water: currently at 0.2% participation level
- 7 new participant requests for 32,000 AF of yield
- Potential dead pool reduction may make more storage space available
- Sites participation rebalancing efforts expected in Fall 2022



Request Opportunity to Increase Participation

- Provide letter requesting to be on waiting list for future increase
 - Request ~6 TAF of annual yield and 37.4 TAF of storage space
 - Secures position on waiting list, but does not commit VW to increase

Rationale

- Preserving options
- Future opportunities may be decreased if no action
- Evolving climate change analysis
- No additional financial investment at this time
- No impact to water rates

Recommended request is within FY 23 budget & would not require water rate increase


