ADOPTING THE 2022 CENTRAL VALLEY PROJECT IMPROVEMENT ACT WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, Section 210 of the Reclamation Reform Act of 1982 (Public Law 97-293; 43 U.S.C. 390jj) requires districts with repayment or water service contracts pursuant to Federal Reclamation Law or the Water Supply Act of 1958 to develop and maintain water conservation plans containing definite goals, appropriate water conservation measures, and time schedules for meeting conservation objectives; and

WHEREAS, Section No. 3405 (e) of the Central Valley Project Improvement Act (CVPIA) of 1992 (Title XXXIV, Public Law 102-575, 106 Stat. 4713) requires the Secretary of the Interior to establish an office to develop criteria for evaluating water conservation plans developed by Central Valley Project (CVP) contractors, and to evaluate the adequacy of plans submitted by project contractors; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara Valley Water District (Valley Water) is a CVP contractor and has a repayment contract, and therefore prepared a water management plan that is consistent with the criteria of the United States Bureau of Reclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Santa Clara Valley Water District does hereby adopt the 2022 CVPIA Water Management Plan.
