- Update every five years
- Statutory deadline end of year
- Failure to adopt a water management plan could jeopardize continued delivery of CVP water

Highlights of the Plan

- All CVP water delivered to agriculture and urban is measured
- 197,800 AF of surface water supplies in 2020
- Promoting water efficiency in agricultural practices
- Water conservation programs to permanently reduce urban water use
