Thanks for reaching out. Could you provide more information on the location of portable toilet facility you're referring to in your message?

Several weeks ago, Valley Water relocated one of our facilities that had been located near Bascom Ave. (light blue dot on the map) closer to Leigh (darker blue dot). But that one serves the encampments on the north side of the Creek, and

it doesn't sound like that's what you're referring to. The other dark blue dot is the existing facility on the south side that you mentioned in your message, but I'm unaware of another one right near your neighborhood.

Hi Mark,

I am writing to express our community's disappointment with Valley Water's decision to install an additional port-a-potty without prior discussion or consent from the residents of Hamilton Place (Los

Gatos Creek Trail between Leigh and Bascom Ave.) This unilateral action has disregarded the community's interests and has led to several negative consequences.

We have observed a troubling increase in litter in the vicinity of the port-a-potty. Moreover, the security within our neighborhood has been compromised, evidenced by the recent theft of a section of our fence separating our neighborhood from the trail directly in front of the port-a-potty. In addition, the port-a-potty used to be hidden behind a tree but now is clearly visible to the residents and anyone walking on the trail.

Given that the existing port-a-potty receives daily maintenance, the necessity of a second unit is questionable at best. Therefore, we strongly urge Valley Water to revert to a single port-a-potty with daily service.
