Dear Water District Executives:

Please, please, please DO NOT reduce the cut in water usage compared with 2013 levels to 20 percent. We have too many people using too much water in a county that has a relatively low rainfall, and there should not be any alleviation of the restrictions until our area and the state as a whole has enjoyed historically average rainfall (or better) for at least two-to-three years.

In fact, we are willing to pay more for water if that can enable the construction of new water storage and recycling facilities to ensure minimally adequate supplies for the indefinite future. And we, as retired librarians, are not excessively well off, merely concerned for the well-being of our burgeoning community.

So, please be conservative and decide strategically for the long-term future of our county. Don't reduce the 30% cut-back restriction.
