Here are some comments on the staff report on 2.1 Update on the 2017 Water Supply Master Plan and Potential Storage Options..

- Local projects
 - Aggressive leak repair - leak detection and repair is not mentioned in document
 - In our own transmission network
 - In the retailers we service through assistance
 - Subsidies to cities for certain type of pro water projects
 - Rain gardens / rain barrel / distributed storage — best practices and rebate program - mentioned once - no details
 - Bioswales - not mentioned at all
 - AMI (Automatic Meter Reading) / ALD (Automatic leak detection) - - mentioned once - no details
 - Percolation ponds merchant creators - not mentioned at all
 - Mechanism to reward those who create their own percolation ponds
 - Urban runoff storm water - no cost numbers
 - Fallowing land
 - Nothing really detailed here
- Storage
 - Del Valle
 - Mentioned but no details equal to "Sites Reservoir, Los Vaqueros Reservoir Expansion, groundwater banking, Anderson Reservoir Expansion, Pacheco Reservoir Expansion, Calero Reservoir Expansion, and Uvas Reservoir Expansion"
 - Temperance Flats
 - Mentioned but no details
- Desalinization - one mention / no costs

- Water banking
 - Kern Water Bank - not discussed
 - Expansion of Semitropic - not discussed

- Larger water acquisitions - none discussed in detail
 - Purchase of permanent water rights and / or dry year option purchases - - not discussed in detail
 - Islands and other in-delta projects - not discussed in all
 - SFPUC / Hetch Hetchy / BAWSCA purchases - not discussed in any detail
