

#### CONTRACT NAME:

Amendment No. 1 to Agreement A3861R 2015 Safe, Clean Water Priority D3 Grant Program Between the Santa Clara Valley Water District and the Santa Clara County Open Space Authority for the Outdoor Learning Center and Creekside Valley Loop Trail Project.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve and execute Amendment No. 1 (Amendment) to grant Agreement A3861R (Agreement) between the Santa Clara Valley Water District (District) and the Santa Clara County Open Space Authority (Grantee) to:

• Extend the term of the Agreement by one year from June 30, 2018 to June 30, 2019.

#### EL-5 COMPLIANCE:

EL 5.1.3 states that a Board Appointed Officer shall not make a single financial commitment in an amount greater than the amount specified in the Board-approved budget unless authorized by the District Board of Directors.

The Amendment does not change the not-to-exceed limit of the Agreement.

#### CEQA COMPLIANCE:

The recommended action does not constitute a project under CEQA.

#### SUMMARY:

On February 24, 2015, the Board approved a grant award to the Grantee in an amount not-to-exceed \$200,000 to support the Grantee's development of its Coyote Valley Open Space Preserve Outdoor Learning Center and Creekside Valley Loop Trail (Project). The Board also authorized the CEO to execute no-cost extensions and amendments for the Agreement.

The purpose of the Project is to construct a 3.2 mile, multi-use foothills loop trail in conjunction with an outdoor learning center that will serve as an event venue, outdoor classroom, and a central meeting location for educational and interpretive programs highlighting the riparian and watershed features.

The Grantee began the design process for the outdoor learning center and developed the conceptual design for the adjacent accessible trail. In 2017, the Grantee learned through consultations with local biological experts and the Santa Clara Valley Habitat (VHA) that the site for the outdoor learning center is prime habitat for the western burrowing owl. To preserve this habitat, the Grantee decided not to construct the outdoor learning center, instead, they will submit proposed changes to the scope of the

project. The Grantee will keep the original multi-use trail in the Agreement since the trail does not interfere with the habitat.

The Agreement is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2018 and the Grantee would like to request additional time to submit a revised project scope and schedule for the District's approval. The Grantee is currently working on the revision and expects to provide the proposed changes soon. The Grantee seeks to amend this contract with a 12-month no-cost extension.

The proposed changes to the scope and any additional time beyond the 12-month extension will be reviewed by grants and technical staff and will require Board approval. Grants staff will submit this as a second, separate amendment.

In addition to the no-cost extension request, the Amendment includes updated contact information from the District and the Grantee.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

This is a no-cost extension; therefore, the Amendment has no financial impact.

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT A3861R 2015 SAFE, CLEAN WATER PRIORITY D3 GRANT PROGRAM BETWEEN THE SANTA CLARA VALLEY WATER DISTRICT AND THE SANTA CLARA COUNTY OPEN SPACE AUTHORITY

This Amendment No. 1 (Amendment), effective as of the date it is fully executed by the Parties, amends the terms and conditions of the 2015 Safe, Clean Water Priority D Grant Program Agreement A3861R (Agreement) dated June 12, 2015, between SANTA CLARA VALLEY WATER DISTRICT (District) and the Santa Clara County Open Space Authority, a public entity (Grantee), collectively, the Parties.

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides for the Grantee to receive a grant amount of \$200,000.00 from the 2015 Safe, Clean Water Priority D Grant Program to construct a 3.2 mile, multi-use foothills loop trail in conjunction with an outdoor learning center that will serve as an event venue, outdoor classroom and a central meeting location for educational and interpretive programs highlighting the riparian and watershed features, as well as the natural and cultural resources of the Coyote Valley Open Space Preserve; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee has not yet invoiced or received any of the Project Grant Amount; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial term of Agreement expires on June 30, 2018, at which time the Project will not be completed; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee began the design process for the outdoor learning center and developed the conceptual designs for the facility and adjacent accessible trail. In 2017, the Grantee learned through consultations with local biological experts and the Santa Clara Valley Habitat Agency ("VHA") that the area for the proposed outdoor learning center in the Agreement is a prime habitat for western burrowing owl; and

**WHEREAS**, to preserve the habitat, the Grantee will not construct the outdoor learning center as planned and would like to submit a revised project scope and schedule to the District for review. Due to the need for a revision and to allow time for District staff to review the proposed changes, the Grantee seeks to extend the term of the Agreement by 12 months; and

**WHEREAS**, the Grantee has the dedicated human and financial resources to advance the Project; and

WHEREAS, the District and Grantee seek to update the contact information in the Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual promises and agreements stated herein and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, Grantee and the District hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Section 2. General Provisions. H. Agreement Term., Paragraph 1, is amended by replacing the current expiration date of "June 30, 2018", with "June 30, 2019".

2. Section 4. Miscellaneous Provisions. B. Notices, is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
