RESOLUTION NO. 605

DECLARING INTENT OF BOARD OF  
DIRECTORS OF SANTA CLARA  
VALLEY WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT  
TO MAINTAIN SPECIFIED STORAGE LEVELS  
FOR ENHANCEMENT OF FISHERY VALUES OF  
CERTAIN DISTRICT RESERVOIRS

WHEREAS, the projected importation of water via the Pacheco Pass tunnel route, known as the San Felipe Division of the Central Valley Project, will result in deliveries of the greater part of project water during the winter and spring of each year making it appropriate and desirable that reservoirs of this District be operated to store local runoff for release during the balance of each year; and

WHEREAS, such retention of stored water will be of great value for fishery uses; and

WHEREAS, such values cannot be realized unless basic pools of water are maintained in the reservoirs of the District to permit fish propagation;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of SANTA CLARA VALLEY WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT that upon and after the first deliveries of water from the San Felipe Division of the Central Valley Project this District will, subject to applicable requirements of health and safety, maintain minimum amounts of water in storage as follows:
