- Bidenty/Disebile d. Also neighbors to any special needs that family members have due to app or disebility, in case they're have a close during a flood. Maile a lar with family contract numbers, dector's name, any special medication.
- Family Contacts Post iamly emergency numbers by each phone and see that all mily members carry a card with these numbers in their wallet, adspeak or stored in their mobile phone. Pick a "checkin contact" at family to phone, preferably conside the Bay Area or out of state
- Update your first of personal belongings. Store all vital documents in a safe depict bar or on a second from Inventory
- Meeting Place Fut a solution near our team where ten to manhae our meet if they becare separated and a second section on high ground subside your neighborhood is case if floods.
- Pets Put identification togs on all pets in case gates blow open o Finces blow down. Even taping your phone and address to their collar will last for weeks. Wet tur increases the chill factor, so do of leave pats outside or fied up during a storm - propare a place
- Rudio Keep extra bateries and a batery-operated radio on hand. Tape a last of local news radio stations to it that report Santa Clara County road and weather conditions
- Roofs/Gutters Make sure your cool, windows, rain getters and drainage system con-handle heavy rain. Tarp of seed unplanted slopes.
- Sendbogs Visit the Santa Clara Vailey Water District's sandbag website at www.valleywater.org/sandbags/ to find out about free sandbags and how to use them
- Storage Prepare to store voluables on higher shelves or on a second story. Mow stored furniture as high as possible, as well as gorden and
