Why: The Draft CIP for the FY 2022–2026 was authorized by the Valley Water Board of Directors for release to the County of Santa Clara and all cities within its boundaries for review on **February 23, 2021**. It includes a description, schedule, and map for each of the capital improvements Valley Water plans to undertake over the next five years, a financial analysis and a method of financing such improvements.

In compliance with the State Emergency Services Act, the Governor’s Emergency Declaration related to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Governor’s Executive Order N-29-20, and Order of the County of Santa Clara Public Health Officer dated March 16, 2020 Valley Water’s offices are closed to the public. Therefore, the Draft CIP is unavailable for public inspection at Valley Water’s offices and only available online.

The hearing will continue at the following subsequent board meetings: **April 27–29, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.** It will close during the board meeting on **May 11, 2021 at 1:00 p.m.** Each meeting will be remotely accessible through the posted Zoom meeting link listed on the meeting’s agenda. Following the public hearings, the Valley Water Board of Directors will adopt a resolution approving the FY 2022–2026 CIP.
